THE PRE-TRIAL JUDGE,

Noting the “Order directing the Lebanese judicial authority seized with the case of the attack against Prime Minister Rafiq Hariri and others to defer to the Special Tribunal for Lebanon” (the “*Hariri* case) issued by the Pre-Trial Judge on 27 March 2009 further to an application made by the Prosecutor of the Special Tribunal for Lebanon (the “Prosecutor”) on 25 March 2009;

Noting the list of persons detained in the *Hariri* case (the “persons detained”) submitted to the Pre-Trial Judge by the Lebanese authorities on 8 April 2009 and forwarded to the Prosecutor on that same day;

Noting the referral of the results of the investigation and a copy of the court’s records concerning the *Hariri* case by the Lebanese authorities to the Prosecutor on 10 April 2009;

Noting the “Order setting a time limit for filing of an application by the Prosecutor in accordance with Rule 17 (B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence” of 15 April 2009, in which the Pre-Trial Judge orders the Prosecutor to file his application by midday on 27 April 2009;

Noting the “Submission of the Prosecutor to the Pre-Trial Judge under Rule 17 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence” (the “Submission”) filed by midday on 27 April 2009;

Considering the urgency warranted by the detention of General Jamil Mohamad Amin El Sayed, General Ali Salah El Dine El Hajj, Brigadier General Raymond Fouad Azar and Brigadier General Mostafa Fehmi Hamdan, the hearing provided for in Rule 17 (B) of the Rules must be held as soon as practicable;

FOR THESE REASONS,

IN ACCORDANCE WITH Article 4 (2) of the Statute and Rule 17 (B) of the Rules,

SCHEDULES the public hearing provided for in Rule 17 (B) of the Rules on Wednesday, 29 April 2009 at 2 p.m.; and

DIRECTS the Registrar to take the necessary measures to this end and to notify the present order to whom it may concern.
